



Terms and Conditions: NIDA Corporate Training Giveaway
National HR Summit, Sydney, 31 March – 1 April 2026

Summary

NIDA Corporate Training is conducting a giveaway of one entry to a one-day training course to participating delegates of HR National Summit in Sydney on Tuesday 31 March and Wednesday 1 April 2026.

This competition is a game of chance, the winner will be drawn via random draw at 4:30pm on Wednesday 1 April 2025.

Giveaway entrants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

Eligible entrants

- Eligible entrants include individuals over 18 years of age, who attended the HR National Summit in Sydney on Tuesday 31 March and/or Wednesday 1 April 2026.
- Employees and families of employees of NIDA, NIDA Corporate Training or Key Media/National HR Summit are excluded from entering the competition.

Number of permitted entries

Entries are limited to one per person.

The competition period

Delegates enter the competition by scanning the QR code on their nametag at the NIDA Corporate Training exhibition booth at the National HR Summit. Each delegate is entitled to one entry into the draw.
